Spotted Knapweed— A biennial weed with a large tap root that spreads primarily by seeds. Highly invasive and prefers dry, gravelly sites.



Houndstongue— A biennial weed that forms small “nutlets” that stick to everything including bare skin. Often found in large patches along trails.



Mullein— Large tap root biennial that reproduces by seed. Invasive on disturbed soils and well-drained rocky soils.

WEED BOUNTY PROGRAM

Beginning Monday, May 20, 2019, the Johnson County Weed and Pest will pay \$0.50 per pound for these three species. There are a few rules.... Weeds must be bagged in the clear bags that are supplied by the JCW&P. Each participant will be given up to 6 bags.

No payments will be made for plants collected in any other bag. Plants will be weighed, and checks will be written at the time of drop off. \$50 reward for verified new locations of ventenata or medusahead grasses.

Bags and Program Details can be picked up May-July during normal business hours.

Weigh in/payments will be from 7:00-12:00 pm Mon-Thurs., (NO EXCEPTIONS) beginning May 20th, 2019
