### WEED PULL DAY



**Spotted Knapweed**— A biennial weed with a large tap root that spreads primarily by seeds. Highly invasive and prefers dry, gravelly sites.



**Houndstongue**— A biennial weed that forms small “nutlets” that stick to everything including bare skin. Often found in large patches along trails.



**Mullein**— Large tap root biennial that reproduces by seed. Invasive on disturbed soils and well-drained rocky soils.
