Russian Knapweed was treated this fall on Reculusa. Rod gave a follow up on discussions regarding how to proceed without a Job Foreman position. He reported that he had visited with Les Hook from the City regarding taking over the mosquito program, Les will talk with the Mayor and regarding winter Salt Cedar projects there may be an opportunity to have other Districts help. Rod reported that the Black footed Ferret meeting had been interesting. There are some contradictions with respect to the product labels, the Black footed Ferret, F&WS and the EPA; the BFF working group discussed asking for a letter from F&WS to the effect that since BFF are under the 10j rule in Wyoming & otherwise block cleared across the state, ESA considerations on the label for BFF are null and void. No action was taken, however, by the committee.

#### New Business:

Rod reported that the next meeting will be December 7<sup>th</sup> and asked the Board if they would like to continue with the annual Christmas party. It was agreed by general consensus to have the Christmas party after the business meeting.
